1. School Timings

- a. Nursery UKG: 9:00 am to 12:30 pm
- b. Grades I-XII: 07:50 am to 2:00 pm
- Parents' Visiting Hours: 8:00 am 2:00 pm however, please be informed that parents will be restricted from entering the school premises during the following time slots: 7:30 am to 7:50 am, 11:05 am to 11:30 pm, and 1:25 pm to 2:00 pm. These periods coincide with increased student movement outside classrooms, including recess and dispersal times.

- 3. <u>School Almanac</u> is an important document which is to be used additionally for the following apart from the regular activities of the child and any kind of communication:
 - a. **Scholar's Personal Record:** Mandatory to be filled in by the parents and same to be submitted to the respective Class teacher during the first PTM (April 13th, 2024).
 - b. **Medical History Form**: Parents need to fill medical history form very carefully and in case of any medical conditions, kindly attach the supporting document(s).
 - c. Academic Calendar & List of Holidays/vacations for session 2024-25
 - d. **School Norms:** Details on working hours of school, admin office, PTM, Appointment with leadership team etc.
 - e. School Discipline & Code of Conduct for students, Prohibited Behavior & items, Library rules, Medical Aid, Important points for parents, Transportation Rules, Fee payment details, Issuance of Transfer Certificate, etc.
- 4. **Parents Teacher meetings (PTMs):** Parents are required to attend the event, as outlined in the almanac. Any changes to the schedule will be communicated by the school accordingly.
- 5. Until the issuance of the current year's identity cards, all students must wear the identity cards of the previous academic year. Those who were not issued ID cards last year will receive provisional ID cards, including new admissions. It is mandatory for students to wear these cards at all times while on school premises. If you have not received your ID card yet, please contact your respective class teacher.
 - a. The process of generating permanent ID cards is underway. To facilitate this, we kindly request parents/guardians to update their passport size photographs on the ERP (EduNext) platform by April 10, 2024. The path is here as follows:

- 1. Login to ERP (<u>https://ipsindp.edunexttechnologies.com/Index</u>) on web.
- 2. Enter student's credential.
- 3. Go to My Profile and select parent detail.
- 4. Upload parent's profile photograph.
 - b. We trust that you have already verified the details required for the ID cards during the session-ending PTM.
 - c. The school will retrieve data and photos from its records via the ERP. Therefore, it is imperative for all parents to ensure that their information and photos are up-to-date.

This will enhance safety and security measures effectively.

6. School ERP Portal: The school's ERP (EduNext) system offers numerous benefits, streamlining administrative tasks and enhancing communication between stakeholders. With features like centralized data management, notices, circulars, home assignments, attendance updates, online fee payment facilities, real-time updates on academic progress and many more, it fosters efficiency and transparency.
